Leo Taxil was an expelled Entered Apprentice and reformed pornographer. He became a favorite of Pope Leo XIII in the 1890s when he tricked him with the "true, inner secrets" of the Freemasons, and his hoax is still accepted as the truth by the gullible. This presentation will give the full story of Taxil and Leo XIII

<u>S. Brent Morris</u>, 33°, Grand Cross, is Managing Editor of the Scottish Rite Journal of the Supreme Council, 33°, S.J. He retired in 2000 after 25 years as a mathematician with the federal government, and has taught at Duke, Johns Hopkins, and George Washington Universities.

He is twice Past Master (1979 & 2000) of Patmos Lodge No. 70, Ellicott City, Maryland, Past Master (2008) of Quatuor Coronati Lodge No. 2076, London, a Fellow of the Philalethes Society, recipient of the Philalethes Society Certificate of Literature, an honorary Fellow of the Phylaxis Society, Editor of Heredom, the transactions of the Scottish Rite Research Society (S.R.R.S.), recipient of the S.R.R.S. Albert G. Mackey Lifetime Achievement Award, and Grand Abbot of the Society of Blue Friars. He is also a noted personality who has appeared in many documentaries on Freemasonry.
