Re: Dinner Reservations for All St Johns 1P Communications

Brethren,

The Worshipful Master and Wardens are working to improve the quality of the dining experience at St Johns 1P communications. To that end, we have contracted with a new caterer with the expectation of improved selection and food quality. But, in an effort to contain costs and minimize waste, we must now address and enforce our meal reservation requirement.

All brothers wishing to dine at one of our communications must make their reservation by the reservation date found in the Trestleboard (the Friday before our communication can be used as the rule of thumb for the reservation date.) Reservations are to be made with Brother Senior Steward via email at <a href="mailto:si1prov@gmail.com">si1prov@gmail.com</a> or 401.861.1757. In order to meet our quality expectations, the caterer requires an accurate count well in advance of our communication. Most importantly, we cannot just order "extra" each month because, as we all know from our personal lives, the cost of food has increased so significantly that this is prohibitive. The cost of meals remains \$10 with a reservation (at \$10 SJ1P is subsidizing each meal.) If we can accommodate a brother without a reservation the night of a communication, the cost will be \$20 but there is absolutely NO guarantee.

Some brothers have requested to be on the reservation list "permanently" in order to avoid making reservations monthly. To accommodate this request, any brother wishing to be on the RSVP list for the entire year can prepay. A year of meals will be \$100 (\$10 per meal x 10 communications). If this option is selected later in the year, it can be prorated to the number of remaining communications.

Notes:

- Prepaid meals are not refundable nor transferable.

- Brothers may not pick and choose specific months for which to purchase meals.
