

- Commercials will now be required to be provided, in writing, in advance, to the WM no later than the day preceding the stated meeting. Collectively, they will be consolidated into one document and provided to all in attendance at the Tiler's station. For recurring month to month messages simply notify the WM in the corresponding month to republish the original verbiage or to provide any necessary edit(s). All of these protocol changes will be monitored for efficacy and acceptance by those impacted by them. As always, your objective and constructive feedback is always welcomed.


